The Website may collect certain personally identifiable information from Visitors to the Website. Our Privacy Policy describes how We use personally identifiable information and for what purposes. The Business Law Center of the Palm Beaches is referred to in this Privacy Policy as "We," "Our" or "Us" or similar words. Visitors to Our Website are referred to in this Privacy Policy as "Visitor" or "You" or similar words.

Personally Identifiable Information

We use the term "personally identifiable information" in this Privacy Policy to mean information that can be used to uniquely identify, contact, or locate a single person or can be used with other sources to uniquely identify a single individual.

Service-related Announcements

We will send you strictly service-related announcements on rare occasions when it is necessary to do so. For instance, if our service is temporarily suspended for maintenance, we might send you an email.

Responding to inquiries

Based upon the personally identifiable information You provide Us, we may send You an email in response to your inquiries. We will communicate with You by email, U.S. Postal Service mail or telephone, in accordance with your wishes.

Sharing Personally Identifiable Information

We do not share Personally Identifiable Information with Third Parties except as is necessary to respond to your request for information about Our practice.

We reserve the right to disclose your personally identifiable information as required by law and when we believe that disclosure is necessary to protect Our rights and/or to comply with a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process served on Us.

Opt-out

We may send you newsletters or other communications. If you no longer wish to receive such communications from us, you may opt-out of receiving them by following the instructions included in each newsletter or communication or by emailing us at info@BusinessAttorneyPalmBeach.com and list the subject of your e-mail as "Opt-Out."

Log Files/Tracking Users of Our Website/QR Tracking

As is true of most Websites, we gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and clickstream data. We place QR ("Quick Response" Code, sometimes called 2-D barcode) on some of the material on Our Website to enable visitors to access Our Website, and particular pages on Our Website, by scanning the Code using a smartphone. We may track such usage using software of a third party,

We may use this information, which does not identify individual users, to analyze trends, to administer the site, to track users' movements around the site and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole. We may use third-party tracking vendors that use cookies and log files to track non-personally identifiable information about visitors to our site in the aggregate and usage of our website.

Agents, Third Parties and Government Entities

We use outside companies to manage Our Website, including using Log Files, tracking visitors and delivering to Us information about Visitors of Our Website. Our Website also has links to government websites. We may use agents to assist us in communicating with our Visitors, Clients and potential Clients who visit Our Website. These third party companies and agencies are not owned by us. We have no control over government Websites linked to Our Website. These third parties and government entities may receive your personally identifiable information. Such third parties and governmental entities may retain, share, store or use personally identifiable information, and have their own Privacy Policies which differ from Our Privacy Policy.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record-keeping purposes.

We may use both session ID cookies and/or persistent cookies. We use session cookies to make it easier for you to navigate Our Website. If you reject cookies, You may still use Our site, but your ability to use some areas of Our site may be limited. We do not link the information we store in cookies to any personally identifiable information You submit while on Our site except as may be required to download material from Our

Website or for You to navigate Our Website. A session ID cookie expires when you close your browser. A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive for an extended period of time. You can remove persistent cookies by following directions provided in your Internet browser's "help" file.

Security

We follow generally accepted industry standards to protect the personal information submitted to Us, both during transmission and once we receive it. No method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure, however. Therefore, while we strive to use commercially acceptable means and domain hosts prominent in the industry to protect Your personal information, We cannot guarantee its absolute security.
